THE Australian Indigenous Education Foundation, which attracts broad support from business and the finance industry, has worked out a way to get members to actually read its annual report — throw in some drinks and canapes.

Ambassadors to the foundation were invited to The Banking Chamber at the **Commonwealth Bank's** Sydney headquarters on Wednesday night for the release of the latest report and the acceptance of a \$20 million contribution from the federal Government.

The guest list included former governor-general William Deane, footballer-turned-author John Eales, AMP's Peter Mason, the Business Council of Australia's Katie Lahey, NAB director Jillian Segal, Credit Suisse's investment banking honcho John O'Sullivan, UBS's head of wealth management Liz Cacciottolo, CBA executive Barbara Chapman and Rob Coombe of BT Financial Group.
