Over 90 per cent of Indigenous students on AIEF Scholarships stay at school, complete Year 12, and make the transition into successful career pathways.

AIEF has grown from one scholarship student to now having around 450 students on scholarships annually, with a network of over 600 alumni, from over 400 communities in every state and territory of Australia.
