Conditions of Entry

- Videos must be at least 1 minute and no more than 2 minutes long and answer the question: “What would you do if you were Prime Minister?” At the start of the video, entrants must state their full name and home community. Entrants must also include their school and year level.
- Only individual entries will be accepted. Entrants may include family, friends or other participants in the video to support their message.
- Videos must be in landscape format and have good sound and image quality. All standard formats are accepted (mpeg, mp4, mov, avi, wmv).
- Eligible entrants are current students on AIEF Scholarships at AIEF Partner Schools who have not previously won the competition. Students who have entered the competition before are welcome to enter again. If you are unsure about your eligibility, please contact AIEF.
- Entrants must submit the video via email (video attachment, link to Youtube video, or Dropbox etc.) to indigenouspm@aief.com.au. The email must include the entrant’s full name and home community. The email must also include the entrant’s school and year level (if applicable)
- By submitting a video, entrants agree that AIEF may use parts or all of the material provided in promotional activities for AIEF or AIEF’s partners.
- Submissions close at 8:00pm (AEST) on Friday, 19 June 2026. Winners will be notified by email.
- The prize is a round trip to Canberra. The date of the trip is subject to availability but will likely be a weekday during Term 4 of 2026. Entrants under 18 years old must have consent to travel unaccompanied.
